Lombardi once said, “The quality of a person’s life is in direct proportion with his commitment to excellence, regardless his chosen field of endeavor.” True to his word, his life exhibited an outstanding commitment to excellence. As a collegiate player, he was part of Fordham University’s famed, “Seven Blocks of Granite” line.
