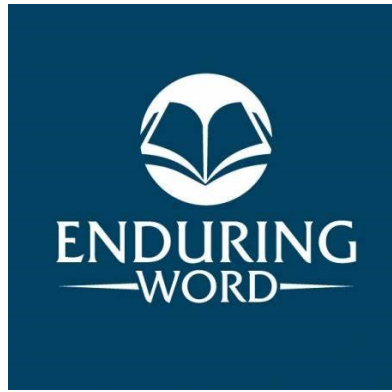

In our woodworking, we sometimes harvest trees that are well over 100 years old, these trees have been through fertile times and the adversity of drought yet persevered.
