

We Can Know the Truth

In the end, we cannot escape truth. We cannot deny it, and we would contradict ourselves if we did. When a person says “There is no such thing as truth” - the statement in itself IS a truth claim. Even radical skeptics who think that all truth is subjective will disagree with those who do not share their opinion. Disagreement implies that someone is holding beliefs that are not objectively true. Truth is assumed by every worldview, yes, even those that deny it exists. Unfortunately, such people are either unable or unwilling to see the contradictions their denial of truth creates. Let’s face it. There is a world of evidence around us. According to the laws of logic and rational thinking, there is only one true way to interpret it. That is, there is only one true reality and any description of it is either true or false. There is no other alternative.

So what?

Jesus told others that He is the only way to God. He said “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me” (John 14:6). To any culture consumed with tolerance, this statement seems incredibly arrogant. Our society has been conditioned to think of truth as something that exists purely because we believe in it.



If the statement made by Jesus actually conforms to reality—there is a God and the death of Jesus Christ is the

only way to partake of eternal blessing with Him—then not only is the statement of Jesus true; it is a moral imperative. If the statement of Jesus Christ clearly represents the facts, then every human being must accept it as true or face the wrath of consequences.

The more anyone tries to escape the truth, the more truth is affirmed. Walking through the evidence God provides has compelled the greatest skeptics to become Bible believers. God inspired the authors. Help other keep an open mind. Don't believe everything you hear. Test what you hear with Scripture. Christians have no fear of the facts. Once you and I investigate the truth found within the pages of Scripture. Once you and I observe the spectacular universe God created. Once you and I begin to see the spiritual significance of following Jesus Christ with heart, soul, mind, and strength. Then our lives shall be blessed and we shall bless others we influence.
